Youth Basketball

Youth Basketball is currently going on for boys and girls in grades kindergarten through sixth. There are approximately 220 kids in the program in Delta on 24 different teams. They started practicing in December and started playing games on January 9th. They will continue to play games until February 13th in Delta, Olathe, Hotchkiss, Paonia, Cedaredge, and Crawford. There are a total of 74 teams in the whole program which is up 5 teams from last year.

Youth Racquetball Clinic

Bill Heddles Recreation Center and Gary West will be offering a Youth racquetball clinic on Saturday, February 13. The clinic will only be one day and will run from 3-5pm. Learn the game and help your footwork and hand-eye coordination for virtually every sport. The clinic is for ages 8 to 18 and the cost is only \$10 per player. Registration is going on now for The City of Delta's 4th year of Spring 4 on 4 Volleyball League until February 21st. The season will begin March 3rd with games played at Bill Heddles Recreation Center on Wednesday nights. A five game season

with a season end tournament is included with the \$60 team fee. Each player is also required to pay \$20 player fee and sign a roster to be eligible to play. The City will provide the game balls and nets.

April Fool's Softball Tournament

This Annual Pre-season tune-up tournament at Mountain View Park on April 10th-11th is the chance for teams to test their ability and have a great time before Summer Softball starts. Divisions for Coed, Women's and Men's teams will be offered. The final deadline to register your team is April 3rd.
