#### **7-8 Grade Girls and Boys Basketball Tournament-**

Registration is going on now for combined 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys' or girls' team until March 5<sup>th</sup> to compete in this year's tournament held at Bill Heddles Recreation Center on the weekend of March 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup>. Each team is guaranteed 3 games over this fun weekend of basketball for a team fee of only \$200. The 1<sup>st</sup> place team will receive t-shirts and individual medals and 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> places will receive individual awards.

#### **Little Ladies Softball-**

Time for all the young Ladies to get set for another great year of softball by registering at Bill Heddles Recreation Center between March 1<sup>st</sup> and April 11<sup>th</sup>. Age as of January 01, 2010 determines which division: 8 & under, 10 & under, 12 & under, 14 & under, and 16 & under. The fee is only \$40.

#### **T-Ball-**

Time for the kiddos to get their folks to sign them up for this year's 4, 5 & 6-year-old T-Ball League. Registration for both boys and girls is between March 1<sup>st</sup> and April 11<sup>th</sup> at Bill Heddles Recreation Center. Team practices will start in early May and the first game will be late May or early June. The games will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The enrollment fee is only \$40.

#### **Hersheys Track Meet-**

Boys and Girls ages 9-14 are encouraged to participate in the Annual Hershey's Track Meet on Wednesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Delta High School Track. Everyone will receive a certificate and ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in each event for girls and boys. The age groups are: 9-10, 11-12, 13-14. (Boys and Girls compete separately) Age is determined as of December 31, 2010. Register at 10:00 am at the Delta High School track. A copy of birth certificate is required at time of registration. The competition will begin at 10:30 am.

#### **Rookies/Pitching Machine-**

Time for the young boys get ready to have another fun summer playing in the City of Delta's Pitching Machine League. Registration for boys ages 7 & 8 is between March 1<sup>st</sup> and April 11<sup>th</sup> at Bill Heddles Recreation Center. Age is as of June 1, 2010. Team practices will start in early May and the first game will be on late May or early June. There will also be an end of the season tournament. The enrollment fee is only \$40.

### **ADULT**

#### **Adult Basketball-**

Adult Basketball is currently going happening on Monday nights. The men's basketball league started playing games on December 7th and will play every Monday through the middle of March. There are 10 men's teams that will get a total of 10 league games and a single elimination season end tournament that will start on Monday, March 8th.

#### **Adult Flag Football-**

Registration is over for the City of Delta's Spring 5 on 5 Adult Flag Football League . There are five teams that will begin their season on Thursday, March 4 with games played at Mountain View Park on Thursday nights through early May. A 10 game season with a season end single elimination tournament is included with the \$250 team fee. Each player is also required to pay \$20 player fee and sign a roster to be eligible to play. The City will provide the flags and game balls.

#### **4 on 4 Adult Spring Volleyball-**

Registration is over for The City of Delta's 4<sup>th</sup> year of Spring 4 on 4 Volleyball League. The 10 teams started their season March 3<sup>rd</sup> with games played at Bill Heddles Recreation Center on Wednesday nights. A five game season with a season end tournament is included with the \$60 team fee. Each player is also required to pay \$20 player fee and sign a roster to be eligible to play. The City will provide the game balls and nets.

#### **April Fool's Softball Tournament-**

This Annual Pre-season tune-up tournament at Mountain View Park on April 10<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> is the chance for teams to test their ability and have a great time before Summer Softball starts. Divisions for Coed, Women's and Men's teams will be offered. The final deadline to register your team is April 3<sup>rd</sup>. Register your team by March 28<sup>th</sup> for a \$50 discount; the team fee is only \$200 before March 28<sup>th</sup> after March 28<sup>th</sup> the fee is \$250. Three game guarantee for the weekend.

#### **Adult Summer Softball-**

Registration is going on now at Bill Heddle's Recreation Center for the City of Delta's summer softball until April 11. This year's league play will begin the week of May 3<sup>rd</sup> at Mountain View Park. You can expect a minimum of 10 games including the season end double elimination tournament that will be played on your regular league night. Five different league choices: Thursday Women's Slow Pitch, Monday-Tuesday Recreational Coed Gold & Silver, Thursday Men's Slow Pitch, Wednesday Men's Fast Pitch, and Friday Competitive Coed. The team fee is only \$275. Each player is also required to pay a \$20 player fee the first night of league play.
