PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Regular Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, April 6, 2010, in the City of Delta. This election will be a mail ballot election.

Applications for absentee ballots are available at the Delta County Clerk and Recorder's Office, 501 Palmer Street, Suite 211, Delta, Colorado on Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., ending at 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 31, 2010.

Ballot packages will be mailed not later than March 19, 2010. Replacement ballots will be available at the Delta County Clerk and Recorder's Office, 501 Palmer Street, Suite 211, Delta, Colorado between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, April 6, 2010.

**ALL COMPLETED BALLOTS MUST BE RECEIVED IN THE DELTA COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER'S OFFICE, 501 PALMER STREET, SUITE 211, DELTA, COLORADO BY 7:00 P.M. ON TUESDAY, APRIL 6, 2010, IN ORDER TO BE COUNTED. Completed ballots must be returned by either:**

1. affixing 44 cents postage and mailing the ballot in the pre-addressed ballot return envelope; or
2. delivering the ballot to the Delta County Clerk and Recorder's Office, 501 Palmer Street, Suite 211, Delta, Colorado, between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., on Election Day, Tuesday, April 6, 2010.

QUALIFICATIONS OF ELECTORS

Any person having registered to vote prior to 29 days before the election and having the following qualifications shall be entitled to vote in this election:

1. He shall have attained the age of eighteen (18) years;
2. He shall be a citizen of the United States;
3. He shall have resided in this State and within the boundaries of the City of Delta for thirty (30) days immediately preceding the election at which he offers to vote. Ballots will be mailed to all active registered electors of the City on or before March 19, 2010. Any ballot packet returned as undeliverable may be delivered to the addressee in person at the Delta County Clerk and

Recorder's Office upon completion of a sworn affidavit and an address correction form.
